

A National Convening of Climate Mitigation, Adaptation and Clean Growth Policy and Modeling Research Organizations

Background:

Ivey Foundation and the Canadian Institute for Climate Choices are seeking a partner to organize and host a workshop in June 2020 of collaborating organizations involved in climate change mitigation, adaptation and clean growth modeling and policy research. The purpose of the workshop is to convene key partners of the Canadian Institute for Climate Choices for a one to two-day workshop in order to:

1. Foster greater collaboration and alignment across Canada's leading institutions working in this space;
2. Better understand the breadth and scope of existing and planned research and capacity in the field of climate mitigation and adaptation and clean growth across Canada;
3. Identify potential areas of duplication and opportunities for efficiencies and shared resources;
4. Identify critical research and capacity gaps and priorities for the coming several years including work that is within the mandate of the Canadian Institute for Climate Choices and that which is best led by external organizations or partners; and
5. Identify potential funding priorities for foundations supporting work in this space.

- 2) A brief description of the approach you would take to organizing the workshop including identifying and working with speakers, developing an agenda and targeted outcomes, etc.
- 3) A rough budget estimate including any in-kind and matching funding your organization might be able to provide
