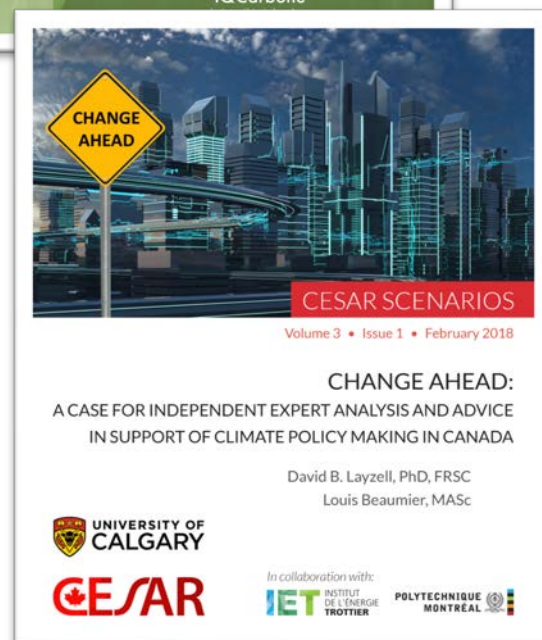
Mission:

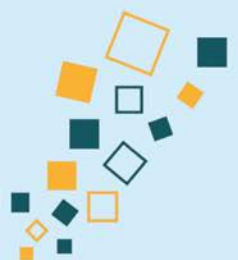
